Pants, Shorts, Skirts, & Jumpers	Shirts
<p><b>Must be black or kaki slacks maroon and silver plaid, shorts or skirts and...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fit at the waste (not too tight or too baggy)</li> <li>• Be free of holes or tears</li> <li>• Be appropriate length (no higher than two inches above knee)</li> <li>• belts are recommended.</li> </ul> <p><i>Jeans, sweatpants, pajamas, nylon, leggings, or lycra material are not acceptable;</i></p>	<p><b>Must be a maroon or gray polo with logo or without and....</b> Logo polo will be sold through a vender at DFB</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fit appropriately (not too tight or too baggy) short sleeve or long sleeve</li> <li>• Have a collar</li> <li>• Be solid maroon or gray with or without logo unless it is DFB spirit wear</li> <li>• Be either short or long sleeves</li> </ul>
Shoes & Socks	Sweaters, Sweatshirts, and Jackets
<p><b>Must be black and/or white</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Laces must be white or black</li> <li>• Be free of any tagging or personal designs</li> <li>• Cover the foot completely</li> <li>• Closed toed shoes</li> <li>• Socks – Black, white, gray, maroon; leggings are acceptable <i>with skirt</i> in cold climate with the above colors only.</li> </ul>	<p><b>When inside the building: Must be maroon, black, or light gray and...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be a solid color with no design, unless it is DFB spirit wear</li> <li>• May be zip-up, pull-on, hooded or non-hooded</li> </ul> <p><b>Outside jackets</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• can be your choice of color and be appropriate wear for school environment</li> </ul>
Hats	Spirit Days
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May be beanie or baseball cap style</li> <li>• Must be worn facing forward</li> <li>• Should be appropriate for school environment</li> <li>• Are to be worn outside of the school building</li> </ul>	<p>For Spirit Days, students may dress out of uniform only if they are participating in the theme and meet basic dress code.</p>
Accessories	Basic Dress Code
<p><b>Acceptable accessories include...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sunglasses (outside only)</li> <li>• Hair accessories</li> <li>• Bracelets, necklaces</li> <li>• Belts</li> <li>• Earrings (stud earrings)</li> </ul> <p><b>Unacceptable accessories include....</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Facial piercings</li> <li>• Bandanas</li> <li>• Tattoos, real, temporary, or drawn on selves with ink or marker</li> <li>• No spiked jewelry, chains or footwear</li> <li>• <b>Absolutely no gang related paraphenilia</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hats, beanies, and sunglasses may only be worn while outdoors and must be removed while in the classroom.</li> <li>• Tops must be short sleeve or long sleeve and cover cleavage and midriff - no spaghetti straps (must be over two inches on sleeves)</li> <li>• No clothing containing sexual innuendo or promoting alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, hate, intolerance, or violence.</li> <li>• No gang related attire, such as bandanas, or gang related drawings, symbols, or writing on clothing, notebooks, shoes, backpacks, etc.</li> <li>• Shorts and skirts no higher than two inches about the knee.</li> <li>• Clothes must fit at the waist.</li> <li>• Open-toed shoes, sandals, flip flops, slippers, etc. are not acceptable.</li> </ul>
